## High Holy Day Services Schedule and Information

**Rosh Hashanah begins on Sunday evening, October 2, 2016.** A complete schedule of services for the High Holy Days is attached to this letter. Please send your membership pledge in full by August 31st or arrange a payment plan in order to receive the same seats that you had in the past. After that date, seats will be assigned on a first-come first-served basis. To reserve additional seats for visiting family members or out-of-town guests, please contact the office so we can try to sit your family together.

### Seats for Members and Out-of-Town Guests

Individual members receive one assigned seat; family members receive two assigned seats. Members' children who are under the age of 18 or full-time college students receive complimentary seats with their families.

**Parents, adult children, other immediate family members, and visiting out-of-town guests** of members who themselves are members in good standing at another synagogue receive complimentary seats, but we would appreciate a donation of \$50 per adult. Out-of-town relatives and guests who are not members of other synagogues may reserve seats for \$100 each. Guests' children under the age of 18 or full-time college students receive complimentary seats with their families.

Unassigned seats in the rear of the sanctuary are available at no cost for those do not reserve them beforehand.

### Children's Services and Babysitting

TBI will hold children's services for each day of Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur morning. We will also offer childcare on these days and for Kol Nidre (if there is enough interest); pre-registration is required, as we need to hire the appropriate number of staff. Please contact the Temple office by September 15 so we can properly plan for these services.

### Courtesy and Consideration

- If assigned an honor during the service, please take your place on the *bimah* at the appropriate time so services flow smoothly.
- Upon entering the sanctuary, if the sanctuary doors are closed, please wait until the ushers welcome you to take your seats.
- Please refrain from wearing strong colognes, perfumes, or other scents to be considerate of those with have fragrance sensitivities.
- Children are welcome at our services. Please bring quiet toys for them to play with!
