Tashlich, the ritual of casting crumbs into moving water, symbolizes ridding ourselves of the misdeeds and errors of the past year, to start the new year refreshed and renewed.

We will also hear the sound of the shofar.

Directions: Main Street to Prospect Street.

Turn Right on Crescent Street.

Turn right opposite Robbins Street to the South Entrance of the Watch Factory.

Locate your assigned group (A, B, C, D). Group B meets on the dock, A, C and D on either side.
